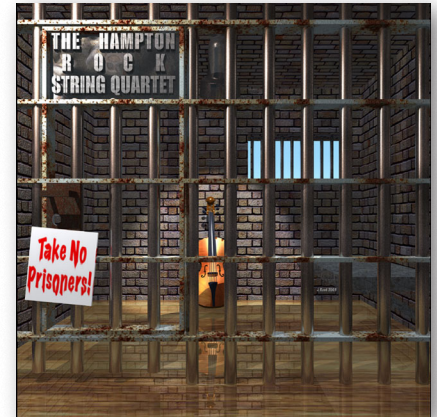
HSQ has, on this CD, risen to the pinnacle of its rock-dom. It is aggressive, pounding, virtuosic

If you decide this is your cup of tea, listen to it loud or don't bother - remember, if you need to zone out - you can always get that other string quartet off the shelf and listen to some Haydn (not a disparaging comment - he's our mentor).

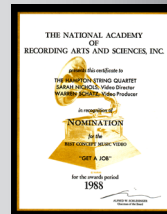
